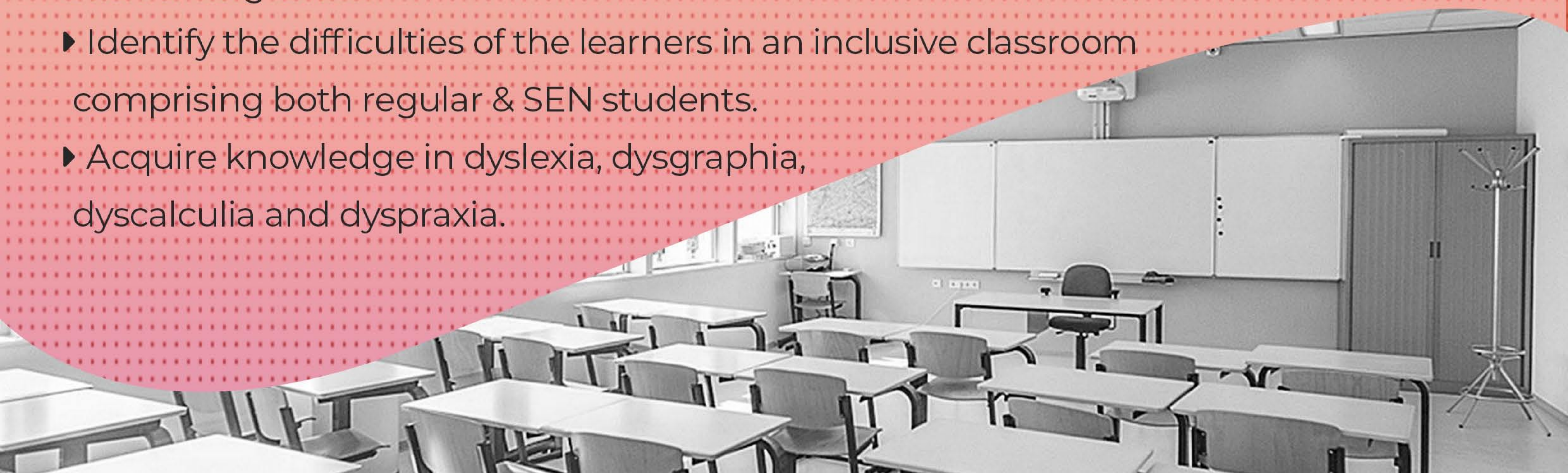
- To identify students with ADHD and understand the different aspects of ADHD
